Facts about Pediatric Research...

- Each year about 36,000 babies are born with a heart defect
- Nearly four times as many children die from congenital heart defects as from all forms of childhood cancers combined.
- In 2007/2008, the Association spent \$10.1 million dollars on research specifically related to heart health and heart disease in children. In comparison, the Association has spent over \$147.5 million on all types of heart disease and stroke research in 2007.
- The American Heart Association's funding for pediatric research is second only to the federal government.
- The Association also funds awards related to maintaining heart health in children
